Movie: **Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince**

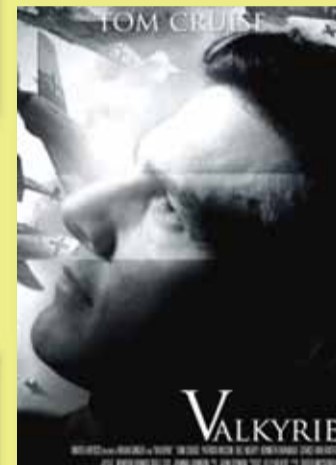
