



"I've learnt to play politics!"

...says Sambhavna Seth. In a tete-a-tete with Tanvi Malhotra she shares her initial experience of living inside Bigg Boss's house

She was hated by many for her abusive language and loud behaviour in the Bigg Boss house. But Sambhavna Seth has no qualms in accepting it. "I'm a very strong person, but when frustration level increases you tend to behave so," she justifies.

"Being completely disconnected with the outside world, for almost two months I definitely went through a lot of stress," she adds. She feels that situations were purposely created in the house that forced her to abuse certain housemates. "I've never bitched in my real life. But inside I did all of that!" she asserts. "Payal Rohatgi was one such participant who made it difficult for me," says Sambhavna. "I've never hated her. But she did something that made me think, 'ladkiyan itni buri bhi ho sakti hai?'"

Even after being evicted from the Bigg Boss's house, Sambhavna has only spoken her mind. "Woh teeli dekar jaati thi. Besides she bitched about me for no reason. So she has exposed herself in the house, not me!" Sambhavna clarifies. Having said that, Sambhavna may only try to be politically correct but we've all seen more than just her personality to think otherwise!

Apart from Payal, Sambhavna was also seen in tiff with Raja Chaudhary. "We were great friends in the show and kept pulling each others legs." However, the audience was in for a surprise when they started to abuse and fight. In fact there were questions raised on whether the show was being scripted. "Nothing is scripted!" Sambhavna justifies. "I had a fight with Raja and he was totally responsible for it!" she answers. "I was actually hurt by Ashutosh and Raja when they started abusing and calling me dramebaaz. Watching him abuse, even I reacted the same way," she elaborates. But Sambhavna feels that if girls are bold and blunt, everyone hates them. And she was hated by many in the house for her behaviour. "Nobody spoke to me for days together," she says.

natak. Initially I wasn't dancing because of the sombre mood in the house. All the other housemates were upset with what happened," she replies instantly. "Raja pulled me to dance because a task was given. And when I saw Payal looking at us and bitching to Rahul, I whispered to Raja to continue dancing just to make her feel jealous," says Sambhavna. She feels that Payal is one of those girls who couldn't see any girl getting closer to a guy.

On forming teams and deciding on the nominations she feels that it was initiated by Rakhi, Rahul and Monica. "Had I not formed team with Raja and Ashu, I would have been evicted in the second week itself," she states. If her fight with Raja was most spoken about, then the one with Sanjay Nirupam is also debatable. In the very first week of their stay, the comment made by the politician hurt her sentiments. "It was an unfortunate incident but now all the air has been cleared. Both of us realised and sorted this issue," she says adding that, "Sanjayji is a very nice person."

It's true that one cannot judge a person in one week. So today if we hear Sambhavna speak at length about Payal, it's only because she has known her for a while. "We both belong to the same industry, but unlike her, I never wanted to prove anything to anyone. It's a reality show so be yourself. Jo aapke dil mein hai bolo! If she says it was only a game then she is wrong," remarks Sambhavna who even calls Payal a 'fake.'

Sambhavna not only made enemies in the Bigg Boss's house but also found a fatherly and

motherly figure in Eshaan Qureshi and Ketaki Dave and true friendship in Jade Goody with whom she laughed and shared a lot. Talking about her laughter, it was one quality that didn't go unnoticed. "I am like this in real life too. When you have no form of entertainment inside, then aap khud hi mein cheezein doondthe ho, aur has lete ho! Even I did the same, but since I'm loud, my laughter too was loud."

Bigg Boss has definitely changed this item girl's life. "I have become a very strong person and this will help me in my entire life," she says with a smile. After coming out from the house she has been offered two dance shows, but is not ready to spill the beans. "Dancing is what I always wanted to do. Bigg Boss just happened," she explains. Then what made her accept the offer? "Popularity was a major reason why I took up this show. And it has definitely helped me a lot," she states. "I was getting offers even before, but now it's on a completely different level and that's what excites me!" she grins.

On being evicted quite early, Sambhavna says, "Lot of people felt I would stay till the end or at least be in the top three. But it's fine! I've got enough popularity and therefore do not regret it!" she adds. When asked who she thinks will win, her instant reply, "Rahul Mahajan", but goes on to add, "Whatever said and done, I want Raja to win."
