ADMISSION POLICY

Introduction

Masters in Management Studies (MMS) is a two-year full-time management course at Mumbai University. The MMS Programme has a two-tier structure: it consists of a core curriculum, a summer internship, and elective courses. The first year is committed to developing business fundamentals through compulsory courses spanning the areas of economics, finance, marketing, operations, systems, organizational behavior, human resources, strategy, and public policy. The second year offers a plethora of electives in different functional areas that students can choose based on their desired area of pursuit.

The Admission policy is based on guidelines given by Mumbai University for selecting appropriate students for MMS. Please note that Mumbai University reserves the right to modify the shortlisting criteria for final selection at any point in time.

Objective

To help students develop essential skillsets by understanding their strengths and weaknesses thereby preparing them for their placements or entrepreneurial pursuits.

Admission Process:



Eligible students should appear for Online MAH-MBA/MMS CET. Students will fill the application form based on their preference.

DTE will allot MMS College based on their merit. Students have to freeze the seat. Any seats that are unfilled by DTE after CAP round 2 will be filled by releasing new merit list in the Vacancy round.



Eligibility Criteria:

- (1) Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate -
- (i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- (ii) Passed a minimum three-year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by any of the Universities recognized by the University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories, economically weaker section and Persons with Disability Candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) or its equivalent;
- (iii) Obtained non-zero score in CET conducted by the Competent Authority (MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2020).
- (2) All India Candidature Candidates, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Union Territory of Ladakh Migrant Candidature Candidates:
- (i) The Candidate should be an Indian National;
- (ii) Passed a minimum three-year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by the University recognized by the University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent (at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories, economically weaker section and Persons with Disability Candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) or its equivalent;
- (iii) Obtained non-zero positive score in one of the following examinations; CET conducted by the Competent Authority (MAH-MBA/MMS-CET 2020), Common Admission Test conducted by the Indian Institute of Management (CAT) or Common Management Aptitude Test conducted by the National Testing Agency (CMAT).



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(3) NRI/ OCI / PIO, Children of Indian workers in the Gulf countries, Foreign National:

(i) Passed a minimum three-year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by the University recognized by the University Grants Commission or Association of Indian Universities in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent.

(ii) Any other criterion declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.

Centralized Admission Process (CAP):

The Unaided Private Professional Educational Institution shall admit Candidates through the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) as referred to in sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Act. The Government, Government Aided, and University Department shall also admit the candidates through CAP. The stages of CAP shall be as stated below;

- (a) Display or publishing of information brochure by the Competent Authority. The Information brochures shall be published on the website of the Competent Authority. The candidate should read the information brochure carefully.
- (b) The candidate should fill out the Online Application Form as per the notified schedule for respective admission.
- (i) For admissions to First Year Engineering and Technology, Planning, Pharmacy, Pharm D (PB), Hotel Management & Catering Technology, Architecture:
- a. The eligible candidates aspiring for admission on the basis of CET conducted by the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State should apply online for admission. Such candidates need not have to pay the application fee.
- b. The eligible candidates aspiring for admission only on the basis of National Level Examinations mentioned in the eligibility criterion and approved by Maharashtra State from time to time, except CET conducted by the Competent Authority of Maharashtra State should apply online for admission and shall pay the required fees (Non Refundable) as required
- (ii) For Direct Second Year MCA: The eligible candidates are required to fill out the application form Online.
- (iii) Following the details provided on the website the Application fees are to be paid by the candidate online only.

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(iv)The Application processing fee shall be as notified by the competent authority from time to time and the amount is Non Refundable.

(v) The list of the Facilitation Centers shall be published on the website. The Facilitation Center shall facilitate the candidate to fill the Online Application Form, and scan and upload the required documents.

(vi)The candidates will also be able to fill in the Online Application Form and upload the scanned copies of the required documents through any computer connected to the internet from home or any other place.

(vii) Candidates are required to fill in all the details as per the instructions and Upload scanned images of valid necessary original documents as per the requirement of the admission while filling out the online application form.

(viii) The candidate can edit/update the information in his application form before he confirms it at any of the Facilitation Centres.

(ix) After filling in the information and submission of the Application Form, the Candidates shall verify the data filled and correct it if required. The candidate shall take a printout of the form and sign it.

(x) The Printed copy of the Application form shall have a list of documents required to be produced by the candidate to substantiate his claim made in the application form. The candidate shall carry a set of Xerox copies of the required documents.

(c) Document Verification at the Facilitation Centre by the candidate through the method prescribed by the Competent Authority for this purpose. It is mandatory on the candidate's part to produce all original documents in support of the claim made in the application form. After confirmation of the application form data/information cannot be changed by the candidate.
