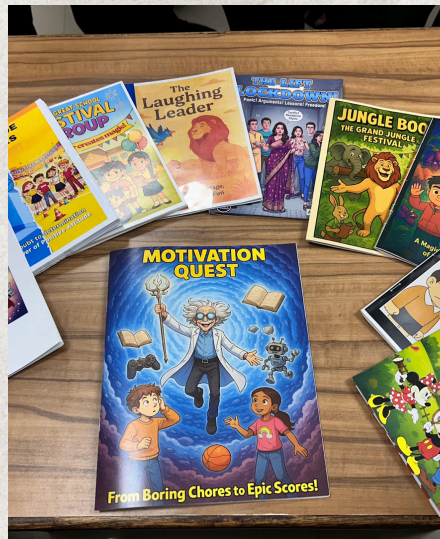


ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

SMART INDIA HACKATHON

The MET Institute of PGDM hosted the MET Qualifiers for the Smart India Hackathon (SIH) on 15th September, 2025. As part of the national SIH initiative, the event aimed to engage students in solving real-world challenges through creativity and innovation.

The teams consisted of 6 members who were given problems and demonstrated their analytical and technical abilities while also taking advantage of qualification rounds as a means to reach the National level, as well as developing team abilities and encourage innovative and real-world solutions through collaboration. Qualifiers were a great opportunity for students to use their knowledge of practical problem-solving and apply this knowledge to developing practical, real-world solutions to problems.



LESSONS IN PANELS

Learning at MET Institute of PGDM goes beyond textbooks. As a trimester-end project, Prof. Dr. Rashmi Nair assigned an experiential Organisational Behaviour activity where students creatively recreated theories as comic books. Instead of simply memorising concepts like leadership, teamwork, and conflict resolution, students expressed them through imaginative stories with unique characters and dialogues. They also gathered constructive feedback on their comics, making the exercise even more interactive and insightful. Through brainstorming, sketching, and collaboration, the activity became an enjoyable and highly engaging learning experience, perfectly reflecting MET's "Learn by Doing" philosophy.

SCENT & SCIENCE: A CAVINKARE WORKSHOP

Cavinkare Pvt. Ltd. conducted an interactive workshop for MET students, effectively bridging classroom learning with practical exposure to Market Research and Consumer Insights. Over 200 women students enthusiastically participated in a live fragrance testing study, carefully evaluating samples on likability, freshness, and intensity, gaining firsthand experience in collecting, interpreting, and analyzing consumer data. The session combined interactive learning with real-time data interpretation, helping students understand how consumer insights play a crucial role in shaping brand positioning, product development, and marketing strategy in the FMCG and personal care sectors.



ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

LABOUR LAWS DYNAMICS

On November 29, 2025, the MET Institute of PGDM held a distinguished guest lecture on employer relations and labour laws, which was facilitated by renowned specialist Dr. Neil Sequeira. The session provided a thorough examination of the key provisions of Indian labour law, the organisational responsibilities related to compliance frameworks, and the fundamental principles governing employer-employee dynamics. Dr. Sequeira also emphasised the new HR-legal issues that businesses must deal with in the quickly changing business landscape of today. His thorough insights greatly enhanced students' academic and professional learning experiences by giving them a clearer and more useful understanding of the legal aspects of people management.



BITCOIN ACROSS INDIA

On 18th November 2025, MET hosted a session as part of The Bitcoin India Tour, a nationwide initiative by SwapSo, an IIT Bombay startup. Banking expert Mr. Amol Bole discussed Bitcoin, blockchain technology, real-world applications, and career opportunities in tech and research. Students participated in a hands-on demonstration of the SwapSo platform, gaining practical insights into decentralized finance. MCA and PGDM students actively engaged, making the session both informative and inspiring interest in the future of cryptocurrency. The session also highlighted emerging trends, regulatory aspects, and the impact of blockchain technology on financial systems, encouraging students to explore innovative solutions in the digital economy.

ADYA: DRIVING DATA-DRIVEN DECISIONS

MET Institute of PGDM organised an insightful session on Adya, an innovative AI-powered platform focused on driving operational efficiency and delivering real-time, actionable insights.
